



## Heating Oil Pollution Liability Insurance Program CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION

### LIMITS OF INSURANCE

1. Up to \$60,000 to clean up contamination from a leak that begins after the registration of a heating oil tank.
2. Cleanup costs not covered by other valid insurance or warranties.
3. Up to \$1,500 reimbursement to repair damages on neighboring property (third party), such as landscaping, flooring, painting, etc. This amount is included in the \$60,000 claim limit.

### EXCLUSIONS

1. Coverage for leaks that begin before registration.
2. Cleanup costs covered by other valid insurance or warranties.
3. Cleanup costs over \$60,000. Repair costs over \$1,500 for neighboring (third party) property damage.
4. Leaks from tanks that have been abandoned or decommissioned for more than 30 days, or from other sources.
5. Removal, repair, or replacement of the heating oil tank, lines, or furnace (this does not include reimbursement of new tank replacement costs according to RCW 70.149.120).
6. Emergency heat restoration costs.

### HOW TO FILE A CLAIM

Owners have 30 calendar days from the date their registered tank is abandoned or decommissioned to file a claim. If you experience a leak from your registered heating oil tank **contact us at 1-800-822-3905**. We will investigate your claim, which may include taking photos of the failed tank and your property. If we accept your claim, all work must be performed by a service provider on the insurer's service provider list. You will receive the list of these providers in the claim information packet we send to you. We must approve all work **before** the cleanup begins.

**NOTE:** *In an emergency situation, such as contamination to a well or groundwater, stream, lake, etc. you should immediately contact the Emergency Management Division at 1-800-258-5990.*

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If you sell your property or ownership changes, your registration under the Heating Oil Pollution Liability Insurance Program ENDS. The new owner must register **within 180 calendar days from the date of the property transfer to continue coverage without a lapse**. If the new owner does not register, they WILL NOT have coverage. Please contact us at **1-800-822-3905** if ownership changes or you switch to a new heating source so we can update our records.
