Restriction found in the Zoning Map recorded September 25, 1953 at 1:30 P.M. in Vol. 2 Plats, Page 42, Doc. No. 272810, and therein set out as follows:

Forestry District:

In the Forestry District, no building, land or premises shall be used except for one or more of the following specified uses:

- 1. Production of forest products.
- 2. Forest industries.
- 3. Public and private parks, clubs, playgrounds, campgrounds, and golf grounds.
- 4. Recreational camps and resorts.
- 5. Private summer cottages and service buildings.
- 6. Hunting and fishing cabins.
- 7. Trapper's cabins.
- 8. Boat liveries, fish hatcheries and fisheries.
- 9. Game, bird, fur and animal farms duly licensed by the Wisconsin Conservation Department under Sections 29.573 to 29.578 inclusive of the Wisconsin Statutes, 1951 edition.
- 10. Mines, quarries and gravel pits.
- 11. Hydro-electric dams, power plants, flowage areas, transmission lines and sub-stations, telephone and telegraph lines and offices.
- 12. Harvesting of any wild crop, such as marsh hay, ferns, moss, berries, tree fruits and seeds.
- 13. Growing cranberries.
- 14. Production of agricultural crops when the land on which these crops are grown is part of a farm located in an unrestricted or agricultural district.
