

HOW TO FIND OUT IF TAXES ARE OWED ON A PROPERTY

You can quickly find out if back taxes are owed on a property - make sure you check BEFORE you buy!

You can do this search online, or with a phone call. It only takes a few minutes and is **one of the most important things you need to check** before buying land because as the new owner you would be responsible for these debts.



Click on the County's Treasurer's page.

Look for keywords on the Treasurer's page like "online parcel search" or "treasurer parcel search".




Find the Treasurer's page for the County.

Go to Google and type in "**name of County** treasurer parcel search".



Access the Treasurer's Online Database.

You may need to accept a disclaimer to access the Treasurer's online database.



Search Using the Property's APN.

You're going to need the **Assessor's** parcel number (APN). Type in the "Parcel Number" box and click "Search".



View Property Tax History

In the APN results, look for keywords like "view property tax history", and see if there are any outstanding dues.



Check Out the Results for Your APN.

Make sure you look only at the results related to your **APN**. Click around and explore your property info.



Sometimes the online information isn't the most current. To be sure, call the Treasurer's office directly and get the most current information on taxes and debts owing.

The Treasurer's contact information should be shown on the online database or the Treasurer's website.
